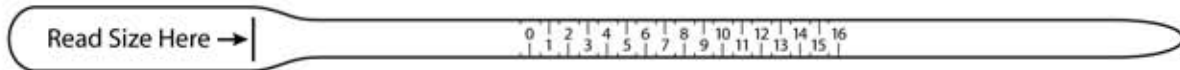


# Find Your Ring Size



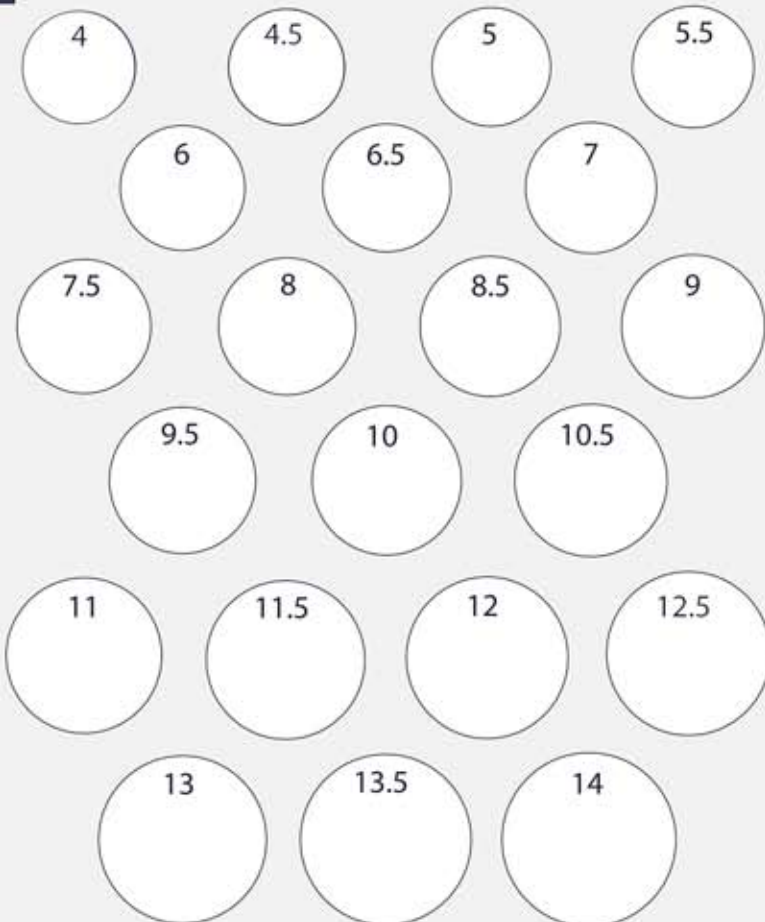

## 1



1. Print this page and place clear tape over the shape above, then cut out the ring sizer just outside the solid line. Cut a small slit next to the arrow. (Tape keeps the paper from tearing)
2. Place the Ring Sizer around your finger, then slip the pointed end through slit with the numbers facing out.
3. Tighten the Ring Sizer by pulling the pointed end toward your finger. The fit should be snug but comfortable.
4. Read the number pointed to by the arrow next to "Read Size Here". Long marks indicate full sizes and short marks indicate half sizes.

If you have an existing ring that fits, simply place the ring with the inside edge of the ring fitting against the matching circle.

**To measure your finger using the reference chart below:**

1. Cut a strip of paper the width of the ring you want and 4 inches long.
2. Find the length of paper that wraps around your finger exactly one time, and mark the paper where it overlaps.
3. Measure that length of string against the closest circumference below.
